2. Assess one's knowledge related to specific areas of nursing practice that will be covered on the ATI Comprehensive Predictor exam.
3. Prepare for the ATI Comprehensive predictor exam.

COURSE GUIDELINES

EVALUATION GUIDELINES

For all graded assessments, the opening and closing dates and times will be posted on the Weekly Topic and Activity Schedule in the Syllabus and on Moodle. Pay attention to closing dates and times. **A grade of zero will be given for any Final Test Tutorials and Practice Assessments not taken as well as failure to submit Remediation Critical Points for Practice Assessments.**

Students must receive a total course score of 70% in order to receive a grade of 2.5 or above for the course. Failure to achieve a 2.5 in NRS 472 will result in the need to repeat the entire course.

TUTORIAL: LEARNING SYSTEM RN

The Learning System RN are tests that relate to the ATI Assessments you are studying. There are two types of Learning System RN Tutorials: Practice Tests and Final Tests.

The best practice is to complete the **Tutorial, Learning System RN Practice Tests prior** to taking the corresponding ATI Online Practice Assessments. *The Tutorial Learning System RN Practice Tests are not a graded item. These Practice Tests will be open all semester.*

Features to utilize when studying the Learning System RN Practice Test:

- HINT button – located in the upper right corner of the screen.
 - Click on the HINT button as you read each questions
 - KEY words in the question will be highlighted in BLUE
 - Red highlighted words are terms that you may be unfamiliar with. Clicking on the red highlighted term will give you the definition of the term.
- Critical Thinking Guide will offer helpful hints on how to read the questions and select the correct answer.
- Select your response.

- Rationale will be shown for the correct response and the incorrect responses. Click on the puzzle piece icon next to each answer to know the rationale for each response. ***It is imperative that you understand the rationale for all of the responses correct and incorrect.***

The **Tutorial Final Tests** will be taken after the completion of the ATI RN Online Practice Assessments.

ATI RN COMPREHENSIVE ONLINE PRACTICE ASSESSMENTS 2016:

There are two (2) RN Comprehensive Online Practice Assessments, 'A' and 'B' which assess the students' comprehension and mastery of nursing content. Each assessment contains 150 test items.

Send verification of the 100% score. Your score of 100% will be entered into Gradebook.

RN ATI COMPREHENSIVE PREDICTOR EXAMINATION

The ATI Comprehensive Predictor Examination measures student knowledge and readiness for success on NCLEX-RN. Assessment items represent all major NCLEX Client Needs categories. The percentage of test items per category is similar to the percentage of test items per category on the NCLEX-RN. The ATI Comprehensive Predictor Examination has 180 items. This exam is a paper-pencil. Please bring a #2 pencil with an eraser and ATI Paper/Pencil ID number. Obtain this number from the ATI website homepage. Click on “My Account” (lower left of screen), and your Paper/Pencil ID will be displayed, along with a link that will print it for you. You cannot test without this number. Phones cannot be used. Please refrain from bringing any water bottles or cups into the testing area. In addition, all coats, purses, bags, hats, and other personal belongings must be placed in the front of the room.

The ATI Comprehensive Predictor Examination is a requirement for graduation from the School of Nursing. **Students take this examination during the semester in which they are enrolled in NRS 4121: Nursing Synthesis. Students must achieve a minimum score on the examination of 68.7% which correlates with the 89% benchmark which is the “predicted probability of passing NCLEX” on the first attempt. The grade that a student obtains on the ATI Comprehensive Predictor Examination is not recorded in Moodle.**

The Paper-Pencil Examinations are sent to the ATI for scoring. Date and Time for availability of the RN ATI COMPREHENSIVE PREDICTOR EXAMINATION results will be posted on MOODLE. When results are available follow the Critical Points Remediation Process if you did not achieve the 89% benchmark.

The office of the Associate Dean will administer the exam a minimum of three times each semester. Students may take the ATI Comprehensive Predictor Examination as many times as necessary to achieve the required benchmark. When a student successfully achieves the required benchmark, he/she will be eligible for graduation at the end of the semester in which they achieve the benchmark.

RN ATI COMPREHENSIVE PREDICTOR RETAKE EXAMINATION

For students who did not achieve a minimum score on the examination of 68.7% which correlates with the 89% benchmark must retake the RN ATI COMPREHENSIVE PREDICTOR EXAMINATION. The Retake Examination is computer based. Please bring pencil, eraser and your ATI log-in information. Please refrain from bringing any water bottles or cups into the testing area. In addition, all coats, purses, bags, hats, and other personal belongings must be placed in the front of the room.

ATI CRITICAL POINTS REMEDIATION:

At the completion of *each* Practice and Proctored Assessment - *Remediation must be completed* when **89%** is not achieved in any Sub-Scale Item in the Individual Performance in the Major Content Area of your Individual Performance Profile.

- Print your Individual Performance Profile - Assessment Results.
- Read TOPICS TO REVIEW on page 2. Review missed items. Know what you missed.
- Return to Page 1. Read the **Individual Performance in the Major Content Areas Section**.
- For Items with a score less than 90% - find those items in the Topics to Review on page 2.
- ***Complete Remediation for those items in your Individual Performance In the major Content Areas with an Individual Score Percentage of less than 90%.***
- For Remediation - Focused Review may be done.
- For Remediation - write three (3) critical points to remember for each topic missed is another method. Write these three critical points in a bulleted form. Keep it short, simple, and focused on just that missed item.
- You must use your Course Textbooks or the ATI Online Text to complete your Remediation.
- Submit your Remediation each week on the Remediation Assignment Link in MOODLE. There will be a Remediation Assignment Link for each Practice and Proctored Assessment.
- ***Remediation is a graded item.***

ATI EXIT EXAM: CRITICAL THINKING

An ATI Critical Thinking Exit Exam will be administered during **Final Exam Week**. The ATI Critical Thinking Exam was given the first semester of the nursing program to assess student's level of critical thinking. The ATI Critical Thinking Exit Exam is given for the same reason and is considered the Final Exam in this course. This exam is administered via paper/pencil on main

campus. **The grade that a student obtains on the ATI Critical Thinking Exit Exam is not recorded in MOODLE.** Points will be given in the Moodle Grade Book for taking the exam. If a student does not take the exam, a zero “0” will be posted in the MOODLE Grade Book.

SHORT SYNTHESIS PAPER

Students will write a Short Synthesis Paper. The Short Synthesis Paper is a formal paper. The Short Synthesis is also a group paper. **This paper must relate to a real life patient focused clinical practice issue in NRS 4125 Nursing Synthesis Clinical.**

Guidelines for Writing the Short Synthesis Paper.

- **Formation of a Group:**
 - Students select members of their group.
 - Groups must have 3-5 members. No less than 3 members and no more than 5 members per group.
 - Select a leader of your group. The leader will maintain order, keep everyone on track and upload the paper onto the **Short Synthesis Paper Forum Link** on the MOODLE Homepage. The leader will email the FOR the names of group members by **Saturday February 3, 2018 at 10:00 PM.**
 - A Forum Link will be set up on MOODLE with all member names for each group.
 - The Forum can also be a communication forum to ask questions about your paper.
 - Groups will be separate. Your communication will not be seen by other groups.
 - The Leader of each group will upload your paper on this Link.
 - Your paper will be returned to you on this Link.

- **Introduction of Topic:** Write a few sentences to introduce your topic and its relevancy in patient care.

- **Purpose Statement:** The last 1-2 sentences of the introduction should state the purpose of the discussion. The purpose statement reflects the nursing care that would have offered an optimal behavioral outcome for the patient based on the literature review. Your purpose statement should begin with: The purpose of this paper ...

- **Description of Patient Clinical Issue:** Describe a real life patient focused clinical practice issue that did not have a positive or optimal outcome. Description of the issue will be exactly as it happened in real life. Do not alter the issue. Briefly describe care and treatment as it happened

- **Literature Review:** Perform a literature review that relates to the clinical issue. Use three journal articles; one must be an empirical reference for the literature review. Incorporate in your literature review how your findings would have benefitted your patient.

- **Nursing Implications:** Synthesize the research data from the literature review and discuss its relevance to the clinical issue. Discuss at least two nursing implications. Nursing

implications refers to the responsibilities or actions of the nurse when caring for patients. Consider also what consequences may occur if those responsibilities and actions are missing. Describe how these implications would have benefitted your patient.

- **Conclusion:** Conclude your paper by showing that your implications present a new perspective of the clinical issue. Relate how you considered broader issues and made new connections.
- **Grading Rubric:**
 - Please include all student names on the Grading Rubric
 - A Word Document of the Grading Rubric will be posted on MOODLE.
- **APA Format:**
 - The APA manual is the final authority on all questions concerning formatting.
- **Submitting Paper:**
 - The Group Leader will submit the paper via the Short Synthesis Paper Link on the MOODLE Homepage.
 - **Submit paper on or before Week #10 – Saturday March 10, 2018 by 10:00 PM.**
 - Papers submitted past the due date, will have 5 points deducted for each day they are late.
 - Failure to post the Short Synthesis Paper by will result in a grade of zero (0) for the entire group.

- Introduction of Topic – 4 points
- Description of Real Life Patient Focused Clinical Practice Issue – 12 points
- Literature Review – 15 points
 - Incorporate how your findings would have benefitted your patient – 10 points
- Nursing Implications – 15 points
 - Describe how these implications would have benefitted your patient.- 10 points
- Conclusion - 12 points
 - Conclude your paper by showing that your implications present a new perspective of the clinical issue. Relate how you considered broader issues and made new connections.
